Vendor & Activity Information for Downtown Alton Block Parties

Dear Vendor or Non-Profit Group,

Alton Main Street is sponsoring this year's summer Block Parties, and we are seeking food & merchandise vendors as well as family activities that would complement these popular events and complete the festival experience for attendees. We will be generating media coverage as well as placing paid advertising, so we expect to draw a large crowd!

For a \$25 fee, your business will be welcome to set up in a 10'x10' vendor space to sell merchandise. Local non-profits may set up an informational or fundraising booth for no charge, as long as you provide an activity. (Things for older children and teens to do are especially needed!) A small number of food vendors will be accepted for a \$100 fee. Please note that food vendors will need to bring a K-grade fire extinguisher & any tents used must be flame retardant per the Alton Fire Department.

Vendors and exhibitors will be responsible for bringing all of their own tents, tables, chairs, extension cords, etc. Please note that because vendors will be set up on City streets, you will not be able to stake your tent; please bring sandbags or water weights if needed.

The hours of the event will be 4-10pm, with family activities and entertainment from 4-7pm and live music on the main stage from 7-10pm. The street will be closed to traffic starting at 2pm, so please arrive no earlier than 2:15 to set up and plan to be open for business by 4pm. We ask that you commit to staying until 7pm, but you are more than welcome to remain set up until 10pm if you choose.

There will be three events this year, held on the <u>3rd Saturday</u> of June, July & August. Since space is limited, preference will be given to vendor and activity booths that reflect the theme of the event.

June 15th will be themed "Downtown Drive-In" – featuring 50's & 60's Rock music from Butch Wax & the Hollywoods

- We are especially looking for 50's or auto themed merchandise and activities
- The All-Wheels Drive-In Car Show will follow on Sunday, June 16th (Father's Day) *vendors wanted!

July 20th will be themed "The BIG GIG Local Music Show" – featuring six local original bands chosen by a selection committee.

- We are especially looking for locally-made merchandise and for local charities to join us
- The band that brings the most fans to the Block Party will win the opportunity to perform an opening set for Leftover Salmon, a nationally touring jamband from Boulder, CO at Riverfront Amphitheater on Friday. August 9th *vendors wanted!

August 17th will be themed "Have a Nice Day" – featuring Jake's Leg, a band that has been interpreting the music of the Grateful Dead for over 35 years!
